Guidelines for Selection Process for mentees:

- Submit written application by September 10, 2007
- Submit portfolio (see Portfolio Requirements)
- Terms/ Requirements during mentorship
 - Mentorship program runs on a one-year time frame (August 2007-August 2008)
 - Current member of CCTRID
 - Applicant must be full-time educational interpreter in Bradley, Catoosa, Hamilton, Murray, Walker, Whitfield counties or Cleveland City School System
 - Attend orientation (4 hour training with mentors)
 - Mentor and Mentee will meet monthly (minimum) for one-on-one sessions.
 - Attend (2) Educational Roundtable Discussions and (1) 10 hour CEU granting workshop geared towards educational interpreters.
 - Agree to journal and fill out evaluation and log for all meetings and submit to Program Coordinator- Leslie Harms
